1. A music audition is required for admission into most four-year institutions.
2. A music theory test is required for admission into most four-year institutions.
3. Take your placement test and work with a counselor as certain colleges have specific requirements.
4. Depending on keyboard proficiency upon entry to the Waubonsee Community College music program.
5. The Music Theory and Aural Skills classes are sequential and must be taken in the order in which they are numbered.
6. At least one course from Social and Behavioral Science or Humanities and Fine Arts must meet the Non-Western/Diversity requirement.
