Academic Planning

Effective Fall 2006, all financial aid students are required to meet with the Counseling and Advising department for academic planning before the Financial Aid office will review a file to be awarded financial aid funds. An Academic Plan matching the declared major in Admissions and Records will be required each year in order to be eligible for financial aid. Please call (630) 466-7900 ext. 2361 to request an appointment for an Academic Plan for Financial Aid.

If you have attended any other institutions, you may be required to complete a Transcript Review using official transcripts from all schools attended instead of an Academic Plan. Contact the Financial Aid office before making an appointment with Counseling and Advising.

An appointment is not necessary if:

- You are required to attend a RAP session before registering, contact the Financial Aid office at (630) 466-7900 ext. 5774.
- You have already seen an academic advisor within the last six months; bring a copy of the Academic Plan from that visit to the Financial Aid office.

Payment Options

New for Fall 2006! Full or partial payment is due at the time of registration. A signed Award Offer letter needs to be received in the Financial Aid office before an authorization can be placed on your account to hold your classes without payment. If you do not receive an Award Offer letter and return the signed copy at least 24 hours before registering, you will need to make the minimum payment when you register or you will be dropped from your classes. Authorizations will only be given to students who are eligible for Pell, MAP, and some scholarships.
