

Application for the Elmhurst Honors Program Scholarship

The Office of Admission at Elmhurst College takes pride in acknowledging the scholastic achievements of their transfer students. Waubonsee Community College is partnering with Elmhurst University in awarding one full tuition scholarship (fees, books, room, and board, etc., are the responsibility of the student) for a Waubonsee Honors Program student to attend Elmhurst. The Waubonsee Honors Program faculty and staff will use the following criteria in selecting a recipient:

- Successful completion of 15 hours of honors credits prior to enrollment at Elmhurst University
- 3.5 or higher GPA and a 3.0 or higher in honors courses at Waubonsee
- Application and acceptance to Elmhurst University
- First-time bachelor's degree candidate planning on full-time enrollment
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) submitted
- Two letters of Recommendation from Waubonsee Community College Faculty
- Two-page double spaced essay descripting future interests and plans
