Rules and Guidelines

Teams

- Teams must have a minimum of four players and a maximum of five players on the court each game (+two alternates allowed to sub in).
- Teams can be co-ed or single gender, but everyone will play each other.
- You may substitute in and out at any dead ball time. Ask the referee to do this.

Scoring

• Rally scoring: A point on every serve regardless of the team that serves.

Play

- A ball cannot be played off the wall or poles.
- Trapping the ball in the net is not allowed.
- Players must rotate after every server exchange.
- Rotation is clockwise.
- Males and Females CAN both jump to hit or block the ball.
- A maximum of three (3) hits per side is allowed.
- The same person may not hit the ball twice in a row.
- The ball may not be kicked or headed at any time.
- No leaning or sitting on the ball.
- A player cannot hit the net or step over the middle line while making a play.
- Games last for 12 minutes. The team with the most points at the end of 12 minutes wins.
- In the case of a tie, play until the next point is scored.

Serving

- Server must serve behind the serve line (the 10-foot line).
- Two members of the team may hold the ball up and server may hit it out of their hands, but they have to be behind the serve line.
- You may not attempt to block/spike another team's serve.
- If a serve hits the net, and goes over, it is fair play.

Attire

- No jewelry or watches are allowed during play.
- Athletic shoes are required (i.e., No flip-flops, dress shoes, or barefoot).

Attitude

• Have fun! And please be respectful of your opponents, officials and people operating the tournament!

Additional Notes

- Masks are encouraged.
- Check in at the registration table between 11:00-11:30 a.m.
- Report the score of your game to the registration table. This is when you will find out when your next game is.
- The tournament is a double elimination tournament (unless we exceed 15 teams in which case the tournament will be single elimination and games will last 15 minutes).
