Chartered in 1978, the Waubonsee Community College Foundation was formed to advance the educational and charitable purposes of Waubonsee Community College. The primary mission of the Foundation is to raise money for scholarships.

Scholarships and awards are available to new and returning Waubonsee students from the many generous donors who support the Waubonsee Community College Foundation. This brochure describes each award's eligibility requirements and the type of financial assistance it provides. Scholarships begin with the fall semester and continue through the summer semester. *All awards are subject to funding availability.*

Individuals classified as **new students** include 2011 high school graduates or students registering for classes at Waubonsee **for the first time** in the spring 2011 semester or those planning to enroll in the summer or fall of 2011. **Returning students** are individuals who have completed course work (excluding dual credit courses) at Waubonsee at any time in the past.

To apply for any of the scholarships listed in this brochure, complete the enclosed Scholarship Application form and provide all other requested materials. A separate application form is required for the John J. Swalec, Jr. President's Achievement Awards. Applications for all scholarships must be received by **8 p.m. on Thursday, February 3, 2011.**
