- NEW STUDENTS: complete the online [New Student Application](#).
- Meet with the [Academic and Career Advising Center](#) to establish a schedule for taking prerequisites at Waubonsee. Submit OFFICAL transcripts for prerequisites not taken at Waubonsee to [Registration and Records](#).
- IF NEEDED: Contact [Learning Assessment and Testing Services](#) to make an appointment for full-time assessment (English placement may be required to enroll in ENG101 or 102).
- To request evaluation for advanced placement in Nursing courses: submit OFFICAL transcripts for Nursing courses not taken at Waubonsee to [Registration and Records](#). I Send syllabi in effect at time of course enrollment to Nursing@waubonsee.edu.
- Review current guidelines for the [ATI TEAS \(Test of Essential Academic Skills\)](#). Determine the best study and testing plan for final testing results PRIOR your preferred enrollment deadline.
- Include valid LPN license with application to be evaluated for prior learning credit.
- Understand that once accepted into the program, students must:
 - Attend the mandatory new student orientation to the nursing program
 - Follow the NUR course sequence and maintain a 2.0 (C) or better GPA in each course.
 - Register and maintain personal Immunization account used to gather and store clinical data for the nursing program. Details given upon acceptance and confirmation into the program.
 - Submit documentation **required** for clinicals:
 - Current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider CPR (online AND in-person components)
 - Current health insurance
 - Medical Clearance and Release, TB test, and immunizations including:
 - COVID-19 – now strongly suggested.
 - Annual influenza by 10/1 for fall admission, before start date Spring admission.
 - TDaP (documentation of boosters)
 - MMR, Hepatitis B and Varicella (titers)
