

Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) Transfer Degree Guided Pathway

Guided pathways are recommended course sequences for earning a certificate or degree. The Associate in Fine Arts is a <u>specialty</u> <u>transfer degree</u> designed for students interested in transferring to a four-year institution to pursue a bachelor's of fine art degree. Students should consult with Academic and Career Advising prior to following this pathway. Academic and career advising professionals are available to guide students on their path to graduation. Waubonsee also has <u>transfer partnership agreements</u> with certain four-year schools and programs to make it easier for our graduates to move on and earn degrees.

General Education: Since completion of the AFA degree does not fulfill the requirements of the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum (GECC), students must complete the general education requirement of the institution to which they transfer.
