



A pop-up box will appear giving you three choices

Click on "Save" and the Proposal file will save in your 'Downloads' folder on your computer



After saving the file a pop-up window will display giving you a couple of options ...

Click on the folder icon and the 'Downloads' folder will appear in your File Explorer

Note: if you click on the "Open File" option the file may open in your default browser – we want to make sure the file opens using Adobe Reader so be sure to click on the file icon




Using your mouse, right click on the Proposal file (it should be at the top if there are multiple files in the folder).

A pop-up window will appear giving multiple options of what to do with the file.

Click on 🔼 Open

The Proposal file will open in Adobe Reader

Note: You must have Adobe Reader (or any version of Adobe Acrobat) installed on your computer. If you do not have it on your computer, go to the LLI page and follow the instructions to install it (see the first slide in this PowerPoint)



The Proposal file will appear in Adobe Reader, and you can complete the form, save it to your computer and email it to the Curriculum Council.

The Proposal file will stay in your computer in the Downloads folder until you delete it – or move it to another folder. You can open the Proposal in Adobe Acrobat and modify (i.e. edit) it as often as you like.
