

LEGAL ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID - Sealed Bids will be received by Waubonsee Community College, on or before July 30, 2026, at 2:00 p.m., prevailing time for the E-Vehicle Charging Stations.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cash in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the base bid amount shall be submitted with the bid. Should a bid bond be submitted, the bid bond shall be payable to the Board of Trustees, Waubonsee Community College. The successful bidder will be required to provide a Performance and Payment Bond in the full amount of the contract, acceptable to the college.

Bids shall be submitted on or before the specified closing time in a sealed envelope addressed with the name of the Respondent, College, Bid Name, Due Date and Time.
