English Transition Pathway (ETP) Program Program Admission Testing Information

Placement testing for the English Transition Pathway (ETP) Program can be completed at the Center for Learning Assessment at any one of our three campus locations (Aurora, Plano, and Sugar Grove). Three tests may be used to determine your placement in the program. They are: **COMPASS ESL – Reading, Listening, and Grammar/Usage.** All three exams are untimed and the tests may be taken together or individually.

When can I take an ETP Placement Test?

- ETP placement testing is given on a walk in basis and no appointment is necessary. Testing is available Monday through Friday during the following times:
 - Monday Wednesday (8:00 a.m. 4:30 p.m.)
 - Thursday Friday (8:00 a.m. 2:30 p.m.)
- ETP placement testing will not be available during the week of mid-terms, or the week before and of finals.

What will be included in the ETP Placement Tests?

- The **COMPASS ESL Reading** placement test is a computerized, untimed, multiple choice test of vocabulary and reading comprehension.
- The **COMPASS ESL Listening** placement test is a computerized, untimed, multiple choice comprehension test of the English language. This test requires the use of a headset and notes can be taken during the listening portion of this test.
- The **COMPASS ESL Grammar/Usage** placement test is a computerized, untimed, multiple choice test of correcting English usage, mechanics, and sentence structure.

When will my results be available?

• In most cases, test scores are available immediately through a printed "Official" score report which will be stamped in RED.

How many times can I test?

 Anyone taking the COMPASS ESL Reading, Listening and/or Grammar/Usage is allowed ONE retest in a 24-month time period after waiting at least one week from the day of your initial testing. COMPASS ESL Reading, Listening, and Grammar/Usage retest fees are \$10.00 per test.

Is there any additional information I need to know before I test?

• ETP placement testing requires basic computer literacy skills, such as the ability to use a keyboard/mouse, mouse-point/click functions, scroll bar navigation, and keyboard familiarity for typing.
