

Underage High School Student Authorization Form

Students accepted for enrollment in college-level courses must have appropriate academic qualifications, a high level of motivation and adequate time to devote to studying a college-level course. Students' course selections shall be made in consultation with high school counselors and/or principals and are [ordinarily] restricted to students in the junior and senior years of high school (or at least 16 years old\*).

Students **below junior status or younger than 16**<sup>\*</sup> who want to register for classes at Waubonsee must present a copy of their high school transcripts and a signed copy of this form (in addition to the standard High School Student Registration and Authorization Form) to the Office of Enrollment Management (2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Student Center at the Sugar Grove Campus).

\*If a student will be turning 16 during the semester he/she is planning on attending, then this underage authorization form is not required.
