
Artistic- Creator

 - ☐ CADD (Computer Aided Design & Drafting)

- ☐ Technical Director
 - **□** \$59,000 year
 - Most have bachelor's degree
 - □ Coordinate activities for radio/TV
 - Mass Communication Transfer (Associate in Arts AA)

 - □ \$56,000 year
 - More than half have a certificate to get into the field
 - ☐ Associate in Applied Science Degree (AAS)
 - ☐ Certificate of Achievement 20 credits
- ☐ Civil Engineering Technician
 - □ \$67,000 year
 - ☐ Nearly 80% associate degree or less
 - ☐ With direction, plan and oversee construction
 - ☐ Engineering (Associate in Engineering Science)
