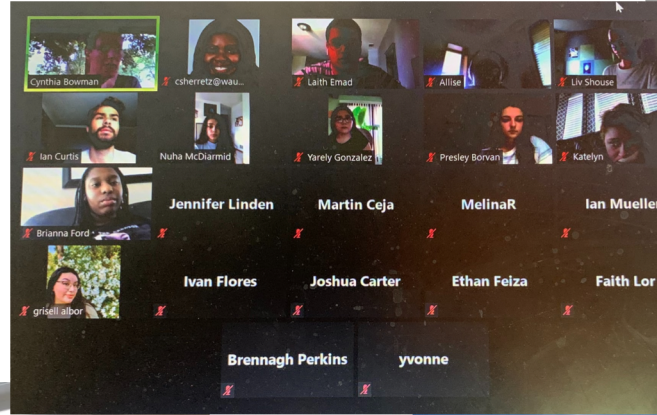

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Eligibility

- Possess a high level of commitment and motivation to complete their degree.
- Demonstrate college readiness through a minimum 2.75 high school grade point average. This requirement is waived for students 21 and older.
- Complete the Application and receive an X-Number
- Placement into college-level courses.
- Send in AP and Dual Credit scores
- Commit to the selected cohort's schedule for the entire program, which includes fall, spring and summer semesters.
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average throughout the program.
- Meet regularly with program manager.

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Getting Started

- Student must fill out the New Student Information Form/Application
 - www.waubonsee.edu/enroll
- Complete the 2021-22 QuickPath Application on **www.waubonsee.edu/quickpath**
 - High School and/or College Transcripts
 - Include Dual Credit, AP, ACT/SAT and/or ACCUPLACER scores
 - One letter of recommendation
 - A one to two page essay (questions are found on the application)
- Fill out the Waubonsee Foundation Scholarship
 - www.waubonsee.edu/foundation
- Applications are due February 1, 2021
- After application is received electronically there will be an interview with the student and their parent
- Decisions are made 5-10 days after the interview
