Notes for WCC

- 1. Transfer students will start at the Level 3 Theory / Aural Skills at WIU after taking Theory I and II at Waubonsee.
- 2. It is possible a student may start at the 400 level of applied lessons their first semester at WIU, but up to discretion of applied faculty at WIU. Transfer students may also delay audition for upper level lessons until end of 1st semester at WIU.
- 3. One course must have a non-Western or diversity emphasis. This is not an additional credit hour requirement. See Counseling for specific course requirements or recommendations.
- 4. Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.
- 5. Music Ensembles may be used to satisfy the Social Awareness/Personal Growth at Waubonsee. However, please be aware additional 2-3 hours to satisfy Human Well Being Gen Ed are required at WIU.
- 6. Transfer students are recommended to take WIU Marketing 327 online the summer prior to third year in program. This will lock in tuition rates for the next year at WIU, count towards the B.M. at WIU and ease student load.
