<u>Please Note: A valid reading and writing score on the ACCUPLACER, ACT, SAT, GED, HiSET, or other multiple placement measure must be on your student record prior to registering for courses.</u>

General Testing Guidelines:

- ACCUPLACER, ACT, SAT, GED, and HiSET scores are valid for three years from the date of testing. High School GPA is valid for three years from the date of graduation. Visit <u>www.waubonsee.edu/placement</u> for additional expiration terms.
- ACCUPLACER Retests: You may try three times within a three-year period. The highest score will be used for course placement. The first try is free. Be sure to study and come prepared for the test. The second try is free. You must wait 24 hours after your first test and spend time studying before retaking. The third try has a \$15 fee. You must wait seven days after your second test and study before this final attempt. Placement scores are valid for three years.
