Spring 2026 English Placement Interpretation Guide *Effective Fall 2022 (Enrollment beginning May 2, 2022)*

General Testing Guidelines:

- ACCUPLACER, ACT, SAT, GED, and HiSET scores are valid for three years from the date of testing. High School GPA is valid for three years from the date of graduation. Visit www.waubonsee.edu/placement for additional expiration terms.
- ACCUPLACER Retests: You may try three times within a three-year period. The highest score will be used for course placement. The first try is free. Be sure to study and come prepared for the test. The second try is free. You must wait 24 hours after your first test and spend time studying before retaking. The third try has a \$15 fee. You must wait seven days after your second test and study before this final attempt. Placement scores are valid for three years.
