



General Testing Guidelines:

- ACCUPLACER, ACT, SAT, GED and HiSET scores are valid for 3 years from the date of testing. High School GPA is valid for 3 years from the date of graduation. Visit www.waubonsee.edu/placement for additional expiration terms.
- ACCUPLACER Retests: You may retest **twice** in a 3-year period. The **first retest** is at no charge and test preparation is recommended beforehand. A **second retest** may be taken after waiting at least one week from your most recent test date. Again, test preparation is recommended. There is a \$15 fee per subject test for the second retest.
