- 4. Community Education: Courses, trips, tours and special events and experiences designed for the personal enrichment of the lives of learners of all ages and to promote lifelong learning.
- 5. Student Services: Services designed to meet the holistic development of all students including counseling, advising, transfer planning, admissions, registration and records, assessment, financial aid, scholarships, career development, student life programming, intercollegiate athletics and assistance for students with disabilities.
