# **NOTES/COMMENTS**

Following this Transfer Guide while completing an Associates in Business – Transfer Degree Path (A.A.) at Waubonsee Community College is highly recommended to complete the Bachelor of Science (B.S) degree in Sport Management at NIU in a 2+2 model. Sixty (60) credit hours are required for the A.A. degree in Business – Transfer Degree Path. Students will complete an additional sixty (60) credit hours at NIU for the B.S. degree in Sport Management. Students should always work closely with the academic advising staff at both Waubonsee Community College and NIU.

# Northern Illinois University

All students pursuing the B.S. degree with a major in Sport Management are required to have a university GPA of 2.50 or above and to have satisfactorily completed all required coursework prior to the culminating internship, LESM 486. A minimum grade of "C" is required in all classes desginated LESM at a 200 or higher level.

# Additional transfer guide notes

The sequence of courses in this Transfer Guide is an example of what a 4-year plan may look like for a typical student based on the stated catalog year. It is recommended that students complete courses in this order due to course pre-requisites (check the appropriate college catalog for more information about course pre-requisites). Developmental course requirements may alter this plan. Students are encouraged to explore summer school course offerings in order to complete their program requirements in a timely fashion or reduce the load during the fall and spring semesters. All students are encouraged to meet with an academic advisor each semester to discuss course scheduling.

# Accreditation

Waubonsee Community College is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission. Waubonsee Community College is recognized by both federal and state agencies administering financial aid.
