Teacher Preparation, Associate of Science to BS in Education in Special Education (Learning Behavior Specialist I)

Waubonsee Community College (WCC; 61 credits) and Northern Illinois University (NIU; 69 credits)

This is a sample course pattern. Students must work with their advisor to develop a curriculum plan that meets their scheduling needs. Summer classes can also reduce the load during the fall and spring semesters.

COMMENTS

Accreditation — Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP); the LBS I program at NIU is approved for professional educator licensure in the state of Illinois with passage of state required tests (general curriculum test, LBS test, and the edTPA).

Graduation, Admissions, and GPA Requirements/Course Grade Requirements/etc.: For NIU admission and continuation in the program: achieve a WCC and maintain an NIU cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, and earn a C or better in all courses required for teacher licensure (a), or S for courses with S/U grading. Candidates must achieve a C or better in all professional coursework including core content course in math, science, social sciences, and math (a). Candidates may be required to complete a criminal background check as part of clinical placements and student teaching requirements. Candidates must pass two ILTS tests (content and general curriculum tests) for licensure prior to student teaching.

Additional transfer guide notes:

- WCC requires 21 23 credit hours in an area of emphasis. Suggested courses from WCC include EDU 200, 202, 205, 220, MAT 202, and PSY 205.
- ECE 145 is currently under consideration for articulation with LTIC 301. LTIC 301 or 420 fulfill Illinois licensure requirements for a multicultural education course.
- Courses listed for summer dependent on enrollment. Consult NIU and WCC advisor.
- LTCY 300 and SESE 370 are NIU courses required prior to entering the first professional semester.
- Candidates may enter NIU professional semesters in fall or spring, for example, if they complete their WCC coursework in fewer than four semesters.
- Candidates may take additional credit hours in any semester to eliminate the need for the summer courses.
- ETT 229 (EDU 205) requirement can be met by passing a proficiency test. Consult with NIU advisor.
- Waubonsee requires 1 Humanities and 1 Fine Arts course to complete the Associate in Science degree. One of these courses must meet the non-western/diversity requirement.
