COMMENTS

Accreditation – NIU's program is accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP). The Early Childhood Education program at NIU is approved for professional educator licensure in the state of Illinois upon passage of state required tests (ECE content test, EdTPA). NIU's ECE program is approved for online delivery.

GPA Graduation Requirements/Course Grade Requirements/etc.: For NIU admission and continuation in the program: achieve a WCC and maintain an NIU cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, and earn a C or better in all courses required for teacher licensure (a), or S for courses with S/U grading. Candidates must achieve a C or better in all professional coursework including core content course in math, science, social sciences, and math (a). Candidates may be required to complete a criminal background check as part of clinical placements and student teaching requirements. Candidates must pass ILTS 205 (content test) for licensure prior to student teaching.

Additional transfer guide notes:

- ECE 145 currently under consideration for articulation with LTIC 301. LTIC 301 or LTIC 420 fulfill Illinois licensure requirements for a multicultural education course.
- ENG 228 is accepted for articulation with LTLA 361 only for candidates completing the WCC-NIU 2+2 course sequence. Students will be required to sign an agreement regarding this equivalency as part of their program. See your WCC advisor for more information.
- Courses listed for summer dependent on enrollment. Consult NIU and WCC advisor.
- Waubonsee CC requires 1 Humanities and 1 Fine Arts course to complete the Associate in Science degree. One of these courses must meet the non-western/diversity requirement.
