## **QUESTIONS**


- 1. For the coloring of the digits, and electronic parts of the scoreboard, is it required that they are white in color when lit?
  - a. White or amber is acceptable. Identify in your bid which color they would be when lit or if they have the ability to be changed.
- 2. Who is the direct boring company that Waubonsee recommends?
  - a. The college's current vendor of record for electrical services is Volt Electric, 9s500 Bushnell, Big Rock, IL 60511. Contact Fred Kala, Work: 630-552-1600; Cell: 630-878-1255
- 3. What does the second picture in Addendum 1 signify? Is it boring or fiber?
  - a. The 'V' shapes coming off the snack bar and dugout represent the approximations for wireless coverage.

## CHANGES/CLARIFICATIONS FROM SECOND PREBID MEETING HELD ON 1/13/2023

- 1. Ryan Hively (WCC IT) suggested we include a floor plan addendum to the manual.
  - a. Please see attached plan with marked rooms: FLD-183 (Data Rm) & FLD-193 (Electrical Rm).
- 2. Ryan Hively (IT) asked how to mount/protect cables to walls inside rooms.
  - a. Jim Pike (WCC IT) responded that D-rings are perfectly acceptable.
- 3. Dave Scott (Correct Digital) asked if they can use indoor/outdoor data cables?
  - a. Ryan Hively (WCC IT) responded yes.
- 4. Dave Scott (Correct Digital) asked if the 24 ft, 4" pole can be installed on the west side of the concession stand, removing one of the 2x2 pavers?
  - a. College agreed to this location. See picture found on page 2 of Addendum 3.
- 5. Parker Roberts (Parvin-Clauss) asked if the pole should also be secured to the concession stand wall?
  - a. College agreed to this change.
- 6. Dave Scott (Correct Digital) asked if the cables are to terminate at a panel within the concession stand?
  - a. Ryan Hively (WCC IT) answered yes.
- 7. Dave Scott (Correct Digital) asked if 40 ft of coil (cables) should be left in the concession stand.
  - a. Jim Pike (WCC IT) confirmed 20 ft is sufficient.
- 8. Both contractors questioned the termination of the bored data cables and the power (from currently buried line at soccer field canopy SW structural beam).
  - a. Jim Pike (WCC IT) explained that since this is for future use, WCC IT will provide Hubbell FSP Panel.
