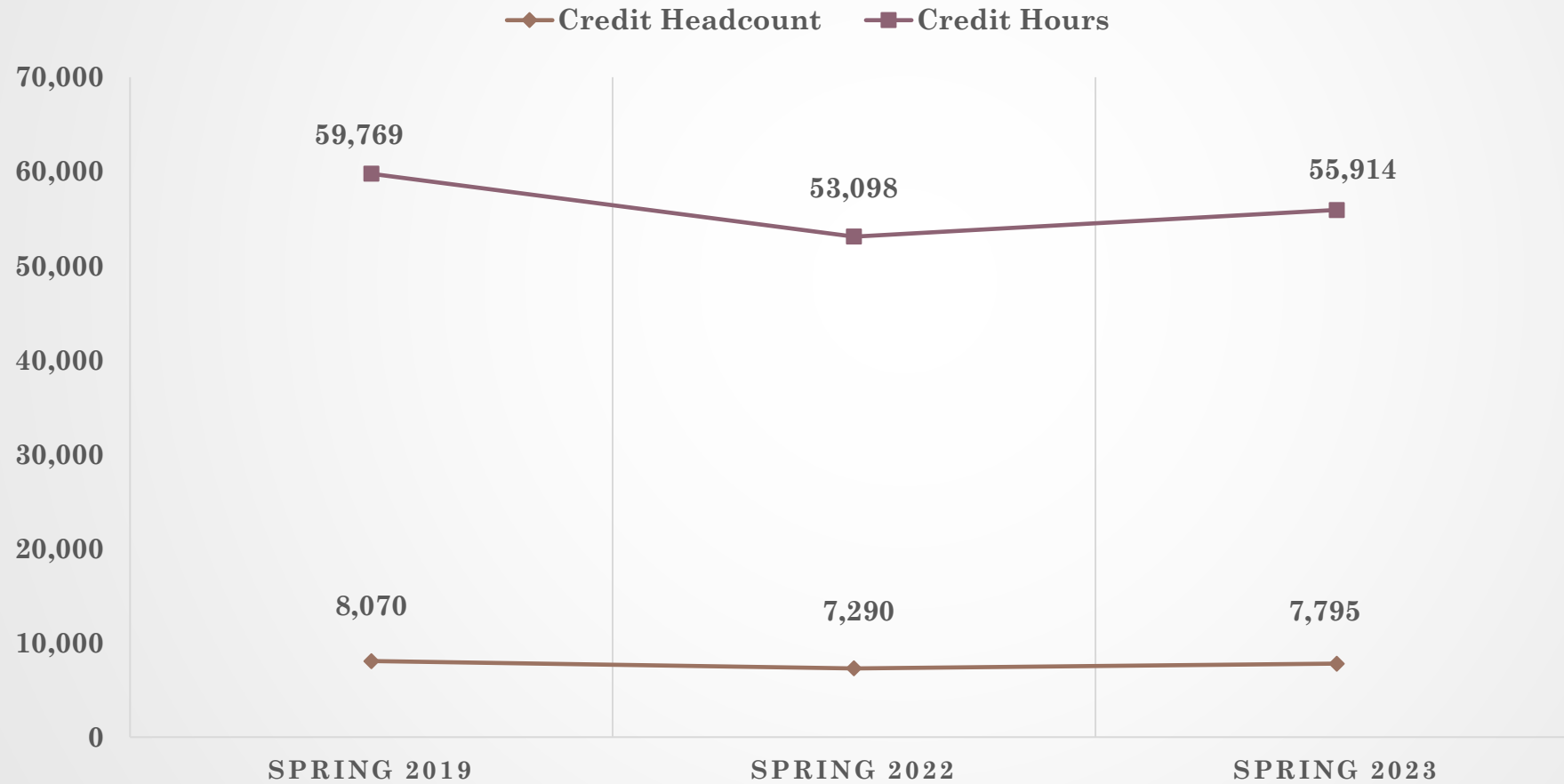

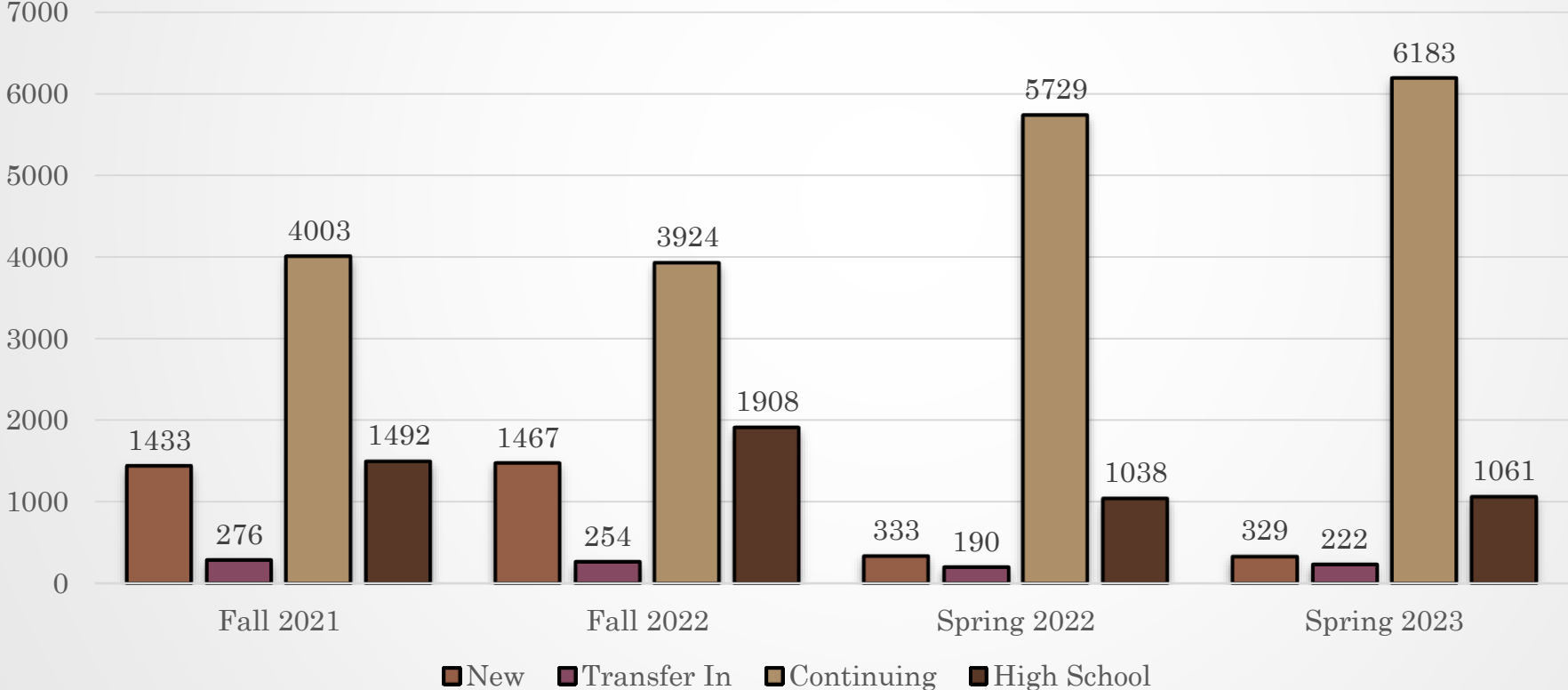

Enrollment is Beginning to Rebound

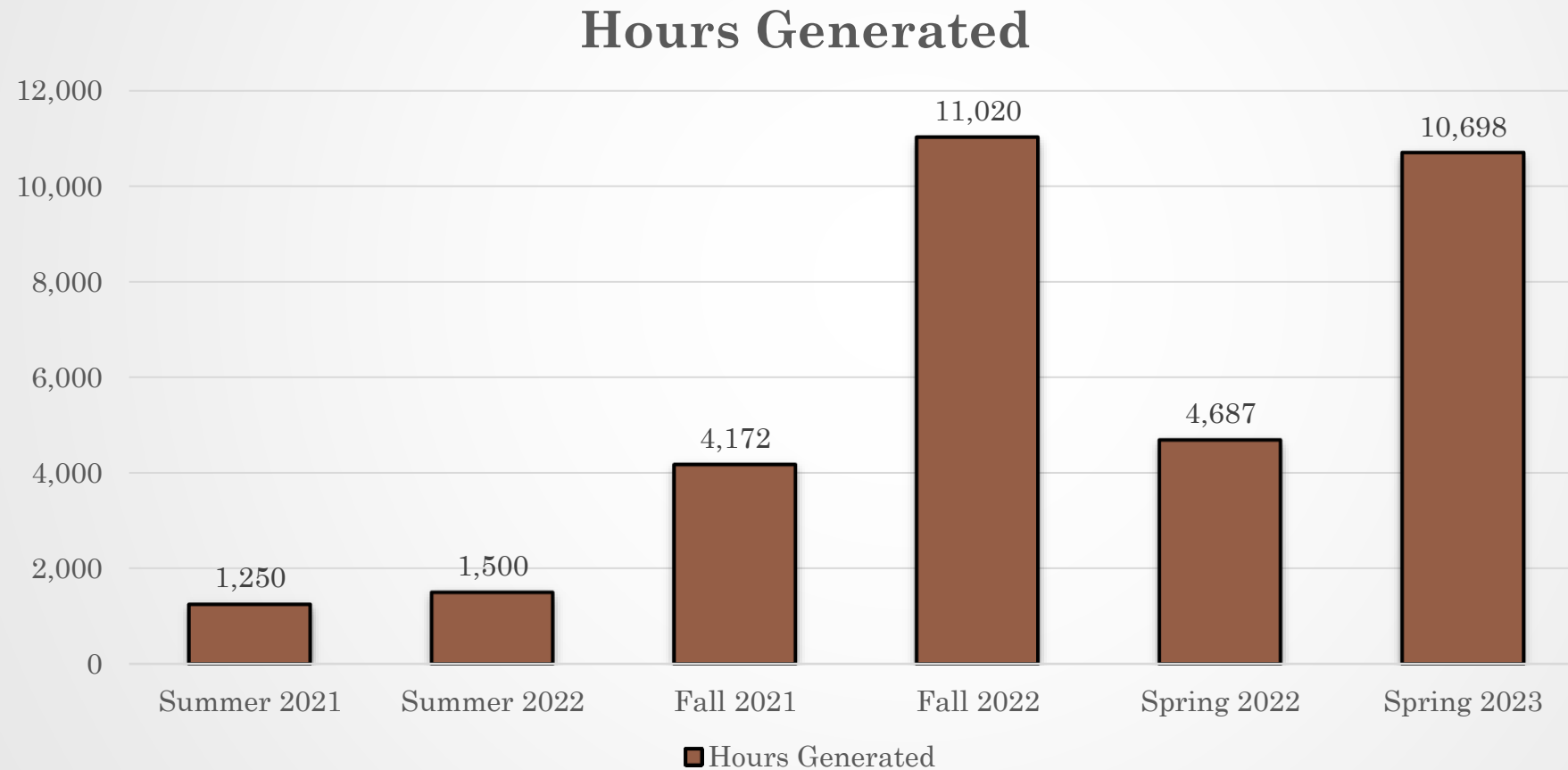


Increase in New & HS Students Fall to Fall; Increase in Continuing Students Spring to Spring

Why Disaggregated Data?

Aggregated Data

- Provides the big picture
- Collective / summary data
- Can hide disparities and differences that exist between underlying subgroups

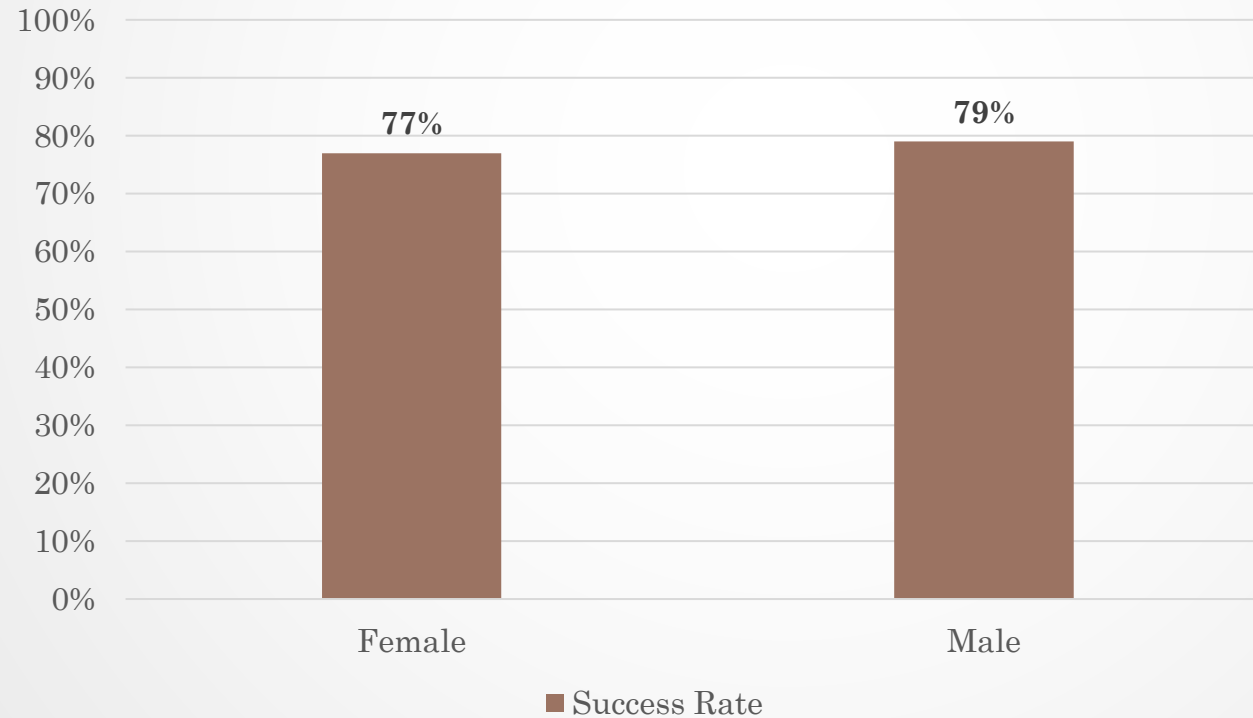
Disaggregated Data

- Provides the full picture and enhances our understanding of a situation
- Can include a variety of different dimensions – gender, ethnicity, age, location, modality, FT/PT status, Pell eligibility, etc.
- Breaking things down into discrete dimensions can make it easier to compare and analyze differences that aren't always reflected in the aggregate data

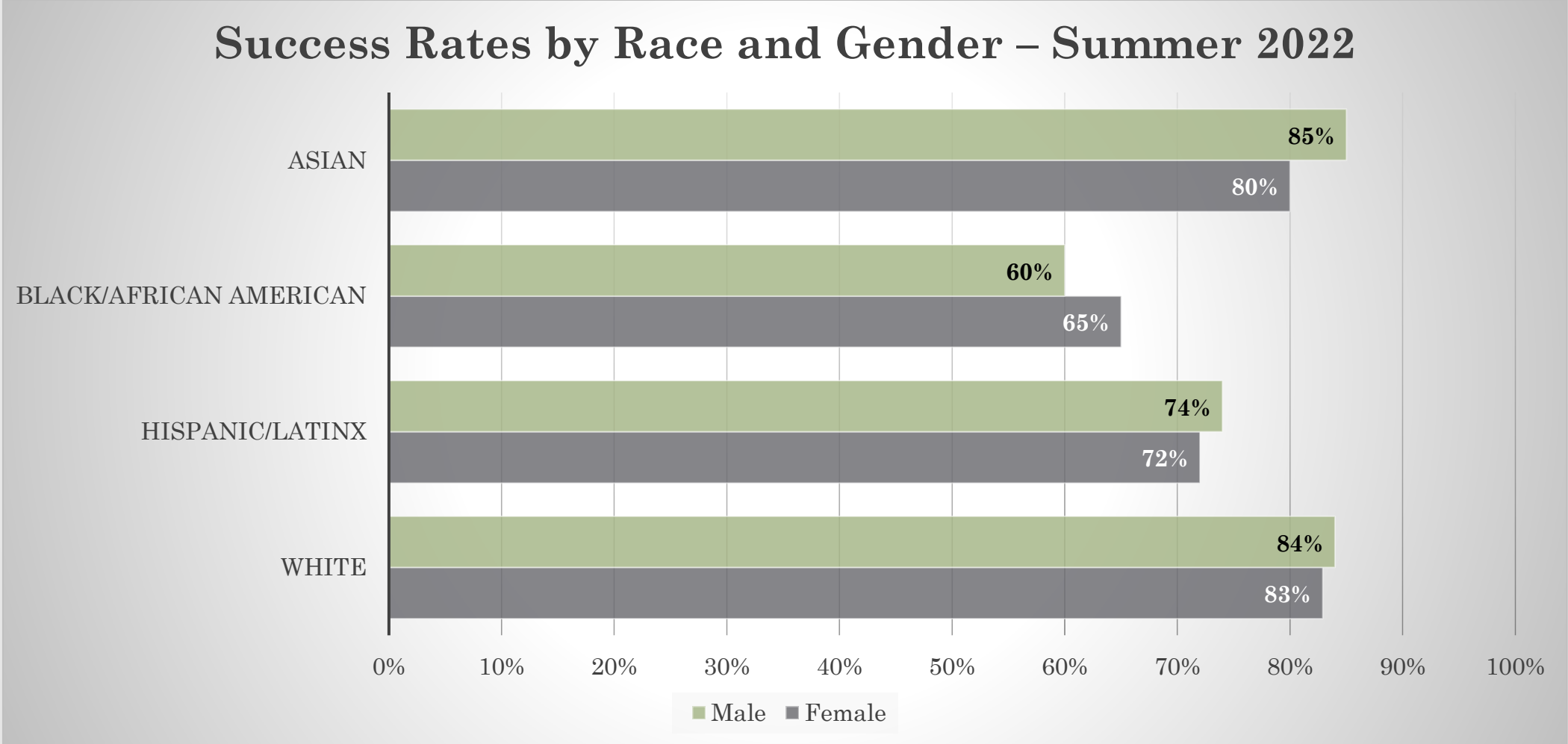
Let's look at Summer for an Example

Overall Success Rate for Summer 2022 was 78%

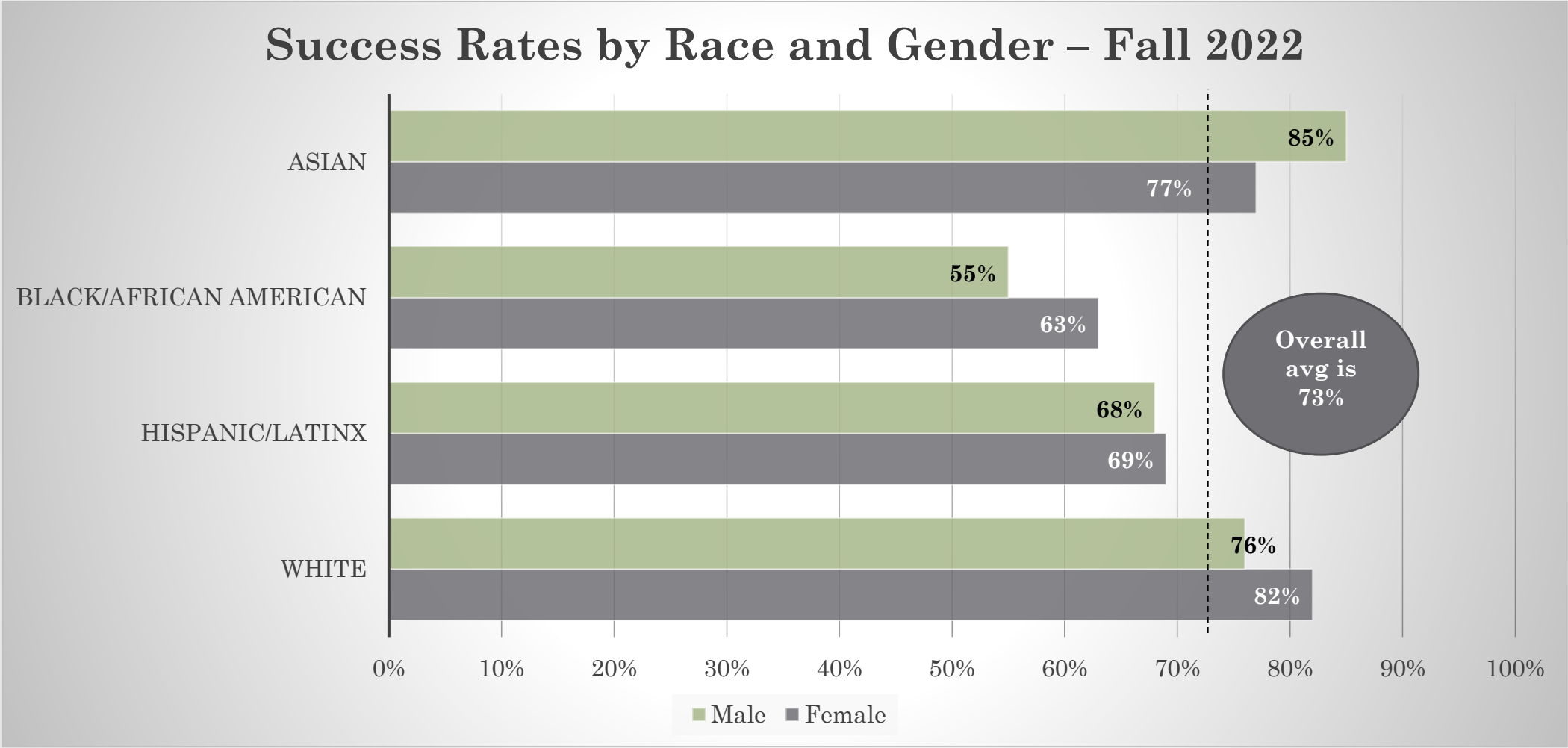
Success Rate by Gender – Summer 2022



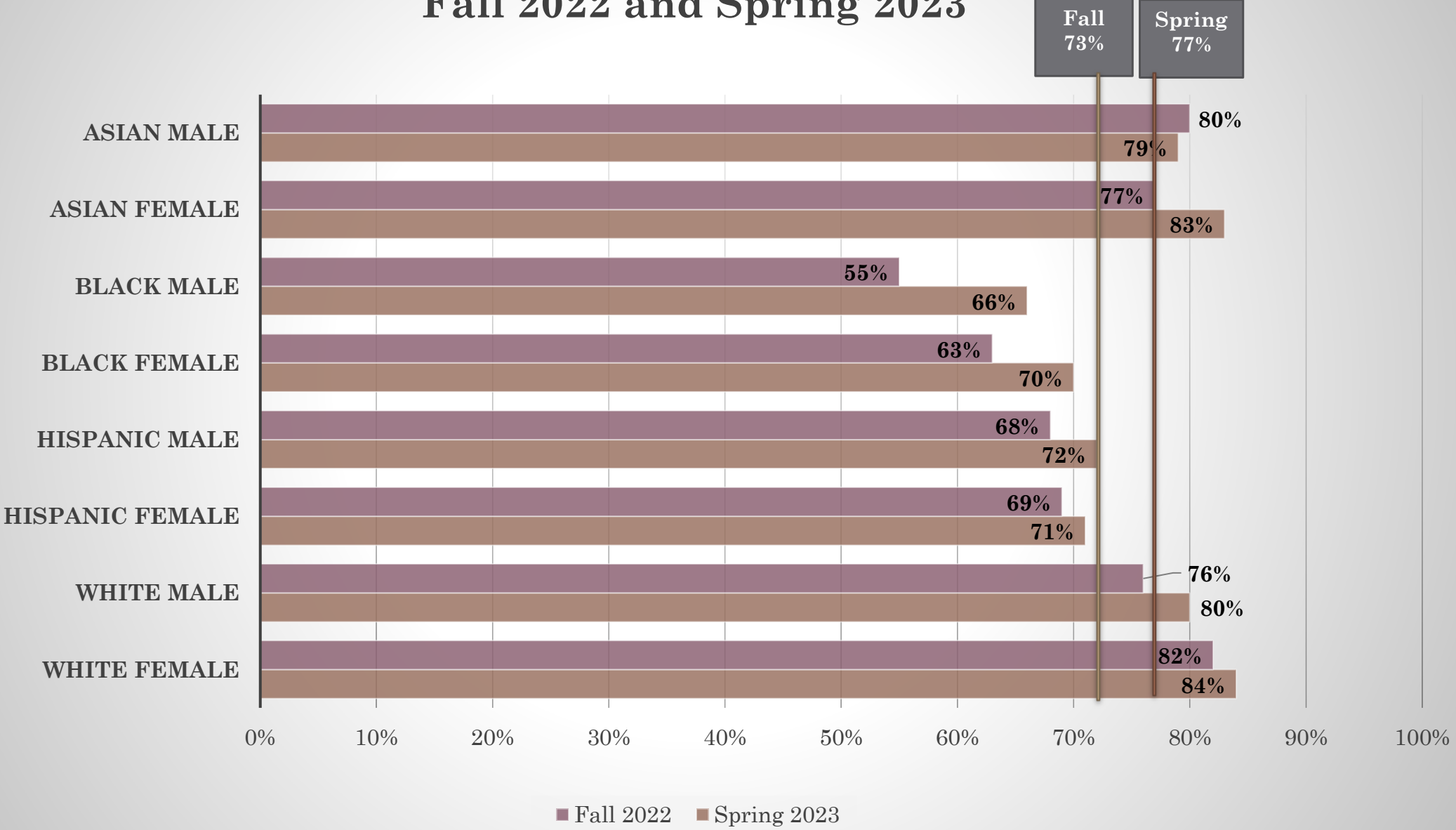
When we combine multiple dimensions, we see a different picture
