Endiro will be located at the Waubonsee Café space on the first floor and open Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. In collaboration, Waubonsee's Campus Operations, Marketing and Communications, and Endiro Coffee (LLC) are working toward a tentative soft opening date in early October. Waubonsee Community College Student Olivia Nieves, of Plano, has been named a 2023 Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholar. She will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.

The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation sponsors the Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholarship program by recognizing 213 new Phi Theta Kappa members with nearly \$200,000 in scholarships annually, with \$25,000 set aside for members who are veterans or active members of the United States military. Students are selected based on their scholastic achievement, community service, and leadership potential.
