All Teaching/Secondary Education Programs require passing the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) or ACT Plus Writing: The Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) is needed or ACT – see below for ACT.

On December 4, 2015 the ISBE State Educator Preparation and Licensure Board determined the ACT can be used to meet the test of basic skills requirement if a student meets the following scores:

- ☐ Students taking the current ACT format (After September 1, 2015) must receive a minimum composite score of 22 and a minimum writing score of 16.
- ☐ Students taking the older ACT format (Before September 1, 2015) must receive a minimum composite score of 22 and a minimum combined English/Writing score of 19. This did not change from previous expectations.
