



Underage High School Student Authorization Form

Students accepted for enrollment in college-level courses must have appropriate academic qualifications, a high level of motivation and adequate time to devote to studying a college-level course. Students' course selections shall be made in consultation with high school counselors and/or principals and are [ordinarily] restricted to students in the junior and senior years of high school (or at least 16 years old*).

Students **below junior status or younger than 16*** who want to register for classes at Waubonsee must present a copy of their high school transcripts and a signed copy of this form (in addition to the standard High School Student Registration and Authorization Form) to the Office of Enrollment Management (2nd floor of the Student Center at the Sugar Grove Campus).

**If a student will be turning 16 during the semester he/she is planning on attending, then this underage authorization form is not required.*
