Transferring to Columbia College Chicago

- The Photography Department at Columbia College Chicago offers a BA in Photography, with concentrations in Fine Art Photography, Commercial Photography, and Fashion Photography. Students may also select the General concentration, which allows them to take courses from each of the specific concentrations.
- Transfer Plans demonstrate the shortest path to completing a degree in your chosen program. They outline the total number of credits required for each major and degree and the number of semesters it will take you to finish.
- Columbia participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). Students who complete an AAS and transfer to Columbia will be eligible for the IAI General Education Core. Full-time status at Columbia is 12–16 credits per term. All degree-seeking undergraduate students are required to complete Global Awareness (3 credits), U.S. Pluralism (3 credits), Writing Intensive (3 credits), and upper division (2000 level or higher) Liberal Arts and Sciences Core courses (6 credits). This plan assumes that you will complete Global Awareness, U.S. Pluralism, and 2000-level LAS core in transfer, and Writing Intensive at Columbia.
- Internships, Independent Study, and Selected Topics courses are not transferable to Columbia College Chicago.
